# SITE INVESTIGATIONS 24 HOUR WEEKEND WORKS - TOORAK ROAD WEST AND ST KILDA ROAD, SOUTH YARRA

# 8PM, FRIDAY 22 MARCH TO 6AM, MONDAY 25 MARCH 2019

Works to enable the construction of the Metro Tunnel are continuing in South Yarra.

Investigations are continuing in Domain to assess ground and environmental conditions and locate existing underground services.

These investigations will build on previous work to finalise design and construction methodology for the twin nine-kilometre tunnels, including the future cross passages.

A cross passage is a connection between two main tunnels. It is important to understand the ground conditions and the services above these cross passages before the tunnelling commences.

Due to the location of these investigations Toorak Road West outbound with be temporarily closed to vehicles between St Kilda Road and Adams Street, South Yarra for 24 hour weekend works from 8pm Friday 22 March to 6am Monday 25 March.

#### When are we working?



### 24 hours

24 hour works are sometimes required during peak construction activities. These are timed to minimise disruptions to the train, tram and road networks where possible. The timing of these works are outlined in the construction information overleaf.

# What we are doing

- Installation of temporary site fencing
- Saw cutting concrete and asphalt
- Non-destructive digging (NDD), using a vacuum truck to excavate carefully into the ground and locate underground services
- Backfilling and reinstatement including ground compaction and asphalting.

# What to be aware of

#### 24 hour weekend works


• These works will take place 24/7 in order to minimise traffic disruption.

# Access for traffic and pedestrians

- Toorak Road West east-bound will be closed to vehicles between St Kilda Road and Adams Street, South Yarra
- Traffic will be diverted east via Anzac Avenue or Commercial Road (refer map for suggestion diversions)
- Arnold Street and Adam Street will be closed at Toorak Road West, access and egress will be via Bromby Street

- Access from Toorak Road onto St Kilda Road will remain open (west-bound lane)
- Access to private properties and businesses will be maintained at all times
- Three carparks on Toorak Road West and one carpark on Arnold Street will be occupied during these works (refer map for location)
- Pedestrians and Cyclists will be diverted around the worksite, cyclists will need to dismount through the diversion (refer map for detail)
- Traffic controllers will be in place throughout the works to direct pedestrians safely around the site.

#### **Tram Services**

Route 58 tram services will not be affected.

#### **Noise**

- There will be some periods of high-level noise generated by saw cutting, non-destructive digging (NDD) and asphalting
- The noisiest periods of work will take place from 7am Saturday 23 March to 8pm Sunday 24 March
- Every effort has been made to program these works to minimise night time noise.

Measures will be taken place to minimise the impacts from our works whenever possible and lighting will be positioned to minimise light spill into neighbouring properties.

All impacts will be managed in accordance with the Metro Tunnel Project's Environmental Performance Requirements. If you have any concerns during the works, please contact the project team via the contact details on this notification.
